- 6. Prior to graduation, students must demonstrate competency in financial literacy by satisfactory completion of FIN 1521 Personal Finance Applications (or an approved substitution) with a grade of C or better, or by a score of 70% or more on a challenge exam for FIN 1521.

All Spanish majors are required to pass a Capstone project (SPAN 4993) with a grade of C or better prior to graduation. Students who pass both the WPT and OPIc with an awarded score of Advanced-Low or higher may be able to fast track their degree progression and earn credit towards their degree.
